# DWS Veteran Services Program

North Carolina receives funding from USDOL to serve transitioning service members, veterans who served on active duty in the U.S. Armed Forces, and other Eligible Persons by providing them with referrals to

- Employment
- Education
- Training assistance
- Other supportive services

# DWS Veteran Services Staff

- All Workforce Office staff can assist veterans with workforce services
- In addition, specialized veteran program staff conduct employer outreach on behalf of veterans and offer additional, intensive services to help veterans overcome barriers to employment
- 52 DVOPS (Disabled Veteran Outreach Program Specialists)
- 44 LVER (Local Veterans Employment Representatives)

# Disabled Veteran Outreach Program Specialist (DVOPS).

- **Conduct community outreach to locate and identify veterans with barriers to employment including**
  - **Disabled Veterans**
  - **Recently separated and younger veterans**
  - **Homeless Veterans**
  - **Economically & Educationally Disadvantaged Veterans**
  - **Ex-offenders**
  - **Other veterans identified with barriers to employment.**
- **Provide intensive services to assist these veterans with reemployment**

# Local Veteran Employment Representatives (LVER)

- **Conduct employer outreach and job development**
- **Provide staff training on veteran services**
- **Act as a liaison with other veteran service agencies and organizations**
- **Organize Veteran Career Fairs**
- **Participate in Yellow Ribbon events in conjunction with the National Guard and Reserve**
- **Act as a resource for the workforce system on veteran benefits and issues**

All Workforce Office staff provide Veterans Priority of Service in the full range of employment, reemployment, job development and training program services.
